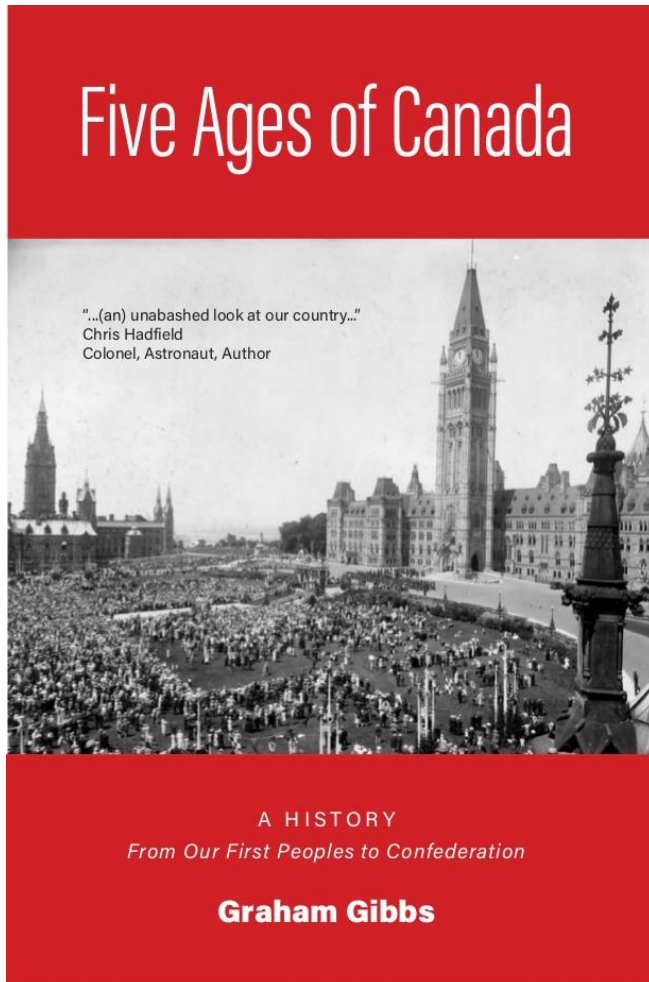


# Five Ages of Canada
